## **Information about the Charities**

The Colorado Center for the Blind provides assistance and training for individuals who have lost or are losing their sight. The center has provided assistance to the blind for over 20 years. The center provides classes and training which allows blind students to obtain the skills needed to achieve success in the world today. It allows them to gain the confidence needed to deal with peers, social and business situations and to believe in themselves and their abilities. The curriculum at the Center includes Braille, home management, travel, technology, life skills, employment exploration, and discussion and support groups. Individuals come from all over the United States to obtain the training offered at the Colorado Center for the Blind.

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The Beacon Youth and Family Center provides help to many children between the ages of 10 and 18 who are recovering from drug abuse, alcohol abuse, and juvenile problems. These children need a safe home and the Beacon Center provides that safety and security. It also offers family and individual therapy for the children and their families. Programs include group therapy for Anger Management, Grief & Loss, and Self Empowerment. Recreational Activities and Medication Management is available. The Beacon Center offers a beacon of light and the opportunity for hope and self respect for these children and has served and helped over 14,000 adolescents during its 35 years of existence. It has achieved licensure as a Residential Treatment Center, a Residential Child Care Facility, and an Alcohol and Drug Abuse Program, and is currently accredited by the Council of Accreditation.
